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Advanced Fall Protection

We all know that if you are exposed to a fall, and only a personal fall arrest system is the only option, well is it, and will it work in the event of a fall.

We hear it all the time, 100% tie off. What does that mean? You can be tied off, have a fall, and still hit the ground or lower level. That is going to hurt!

In this presentation we will discuss and talk about the following:

- Do your employees have the right fall protection equipment for a fall?
- Are your employees using PFAS equipment correctly?
- Do you inspect fall protection equipment routinely?
- Do you store and care for fall safety equipment properly?
- Is your fall protection equipment outdated or recalled?
- What other tips do you use for keeping fall safety harnesses in working condition?
